**AN ORDER OF THE BOARD
NO. P. U. 24(2011)**

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the
3 "*EPCA*") and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL 1990,
4 Chapter P-47 (the "*Act*") and regulations thereunder;

8 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
9 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro pursuant to
10 Section 41 of the *Act* for the approval of a
11 Contribution in Aid of Construction for a
12 single-phase line extension to serve a
13 Service NL Weigh Scale on Route 500
14 near Wabush.

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17 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation duly organized
18 and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
19 utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and
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21 **WHEREAS** on November 23, 2011 Hydro filed an application for approval of a
22 Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of
23 approximately 1,630 metres (the "Extension") to serve the Government of Newfoundland
24 and Labrador, represented by Service NL, to serve a Weigh Scale on Route 500 near
25 Wabush; and
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27 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy, is
28 ninety-one thousand four hundred and ninety dollars (\$91,490), excluding HST; and
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30 **WHEREAS** the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) exceeds \$50,000, and
31 therefore in accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy Board approval is required;
32 and
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34 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Hydro's investment is
35 compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of
36 Hydro's other customers.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of ninety-one thousand four hundred and
4 ninety dollars (\$91,490), excluding HST, to apply to the Government of Newfoundland
5 and Labrador, represented by Service NL, is approved.

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7 2. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
