17	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly		
18	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public		
19	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and		
20	WHERE AC I. Only N. D. H. 20/2011) do Donal annual in the North Actual December		
21	WHEREAS in Order No. P. U. 26(2011) the Board approved, <i>inter alia</i> , Newfoundland Power's		
22 23	2012 Capital Budget of \$77,293,000; and		
23 24	WHEDEAS on July 12 2012 the Poord received on application (the "Application") from		
25	WHEREAS on July 13, 2012, the Board received an application (the "Application") from Newfoundland Power for approval of a supplementary allowance of \$315,000 to be added to the		
26	Unforeseen Allowance approved in Order No. P. U. 26(2011); and		
27	Onforeseen Anowance approved in Order 140.1.0.20(2011), and		
28	WHEREAS s.41 of the Act states that a public utility shall not proceed with the construction,		
29	purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:		
30	purchase of lease of improvements of additions to its property where.		
31	(a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or		
32	(b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5000 in a year of the lease,		
33	(c) and cost of the reasons in the cost of the great of the reason,		
34	without the prior approval of the Board; and		
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36	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power provides the electricity supply to the community of Bell		
37	Island via a three-phase submarine cable system originating at Broad Cove, Conception Bay; and		

WHEREAS on January 9, 2012 one of the submarine cables failed, causing an outage to the customers on BCV-02 feeder and, within two hours, the load on the failed cable had been transferred to a spare cable and service restored to Newfoundland Power's Bell Island customers; and

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WHEREAS in Order No. P. U. 8(2012) the Board approved an expenditure of \$510,000 to complete necessary repairs to the failed cable to restore the Bell Island electricity supply to normal operating condition, which repairs Newfoundland Power initially proposed to carry out in May 2012; and

WHEREAS on April 6, 2012, before the repair work had commenced on the first failed cable, a second submarine cable failed, causing an outage to all customers on the BCV-02 feeder and, with three-phase power no longer available, the restoration of electrical service to all of Newfoundland Power's Bell Island customers took two days; and

WHEREAS as soon as practical, Newfoundland Power undertook to repair the second damaged submarine cable in accordance with the Unforeseen Allowance; and

WHEREAS the capital expenditure associated with repairing the second damaged submarine cable and returning it to service is \$315,000; and

WHEREAS the expenditure of \$315,000 associated with repairing the second damaged submarine cable has reduced the balance in the Unforeseen Allowance approved in Order No. P.U. 26(**2011**) by a corresponding amount; and

WHEREAS Newfoundland Power submits that it is prudent to maintain an Unforeseen Allowance of \$750,000 to permit Newfoundland Power to address unforeseen events that may arise during the remainder of 2012, and requests that the Board approve a supplementary allowance of \$315,000 for that purpose; and

WHEREAS the Capital Budget Guidelines issued by the Board in October 2007 permit a utility to apply for approval of a supplementary allowance provided the utility shows that usage of the account has been consistent with the Guidelines; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the use of the Unforeseen Allowance by Newfoundland Power was in accordance with the Guidelines and that the proposed additional amount for this account should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The addition of a supplementary amount of \$315,000 to the Unforeseen Allowance approved in Order No. P. U. 26(2011) is approved.		
2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
