1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*  
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the  
3 "*EPCA*") and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL 1990,  
4 Chapter P-47 (the "*Act*") and regulations thereunder;

6 **AND**

8 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by  
9 Newfoundland Power Inc. pursuant to  
10 Section 41 of the *Act* for the approval of a  
11 Contribution in Aid of Construction to  
12 provide three-phase electrical service to  
13 Vista Enterprises Ltd.

16 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly  
17 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a  
18 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the  
19 *EPCA*; and

21 **WHEREAS** on July 12, 2012 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a  
22 Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") to three-phase electrical service to Vista  
23 Enterprises Ltd.; and

24  
25 **WHEREAS** provision of the requested service will require Newfoundland Power to  
26 upgrade 637-metres of existing single-phase line to three-phase standard and to construct an  
27 additional 198-metres of three-phase line extension to serve the lift station located in the  
28 Town of Conception Bay South (the "Extension"); and

30 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy, is  
31 seventy-two thousand one hundred thirty-eight dollars and thirty-three cents (\$72,138.33),  
32 excluding HST; and

34 **WHEREAS** the cost of the upgrade and line extension calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a)  
35 exceeds \$50,000, and therefore, in accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy, Board  
36 approval is required; and

1 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's  
2 investment is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the  
3 detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.

6 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

8 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of seventy-two thousand one hundred thirty-  
9 eight dollars and thirty-three cents (\$72,138.33), excluding HST, to apply to Vista  
10 Enterprises Ltd., is approved.  
11  
12 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
