WHEREAS on November 22, 2016 the Oliver Wyman Limited reported that the changes proposed in the revised rating program are supported based on information supplied in connection with the application; and

- The revised rating program received November 21, 2016 from Co-operators General Insurance Company for its Private Passenger Automobiles class of business is approved to be effective no sooner than June 13, 2017 for new business and July 13, 2017 for renewals.
- 2. Co-operators General Insurance Company shall pay the costs of the Board associated with
  this filing, including the costs of the actuarial review.
