1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*  
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1  
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL  
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,  
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application  
8 by Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval  
9 of a Contribution in Aid of Construction for  
10 single-phase service for the Seventh Day  
11 Adventist Church, pursuant to section 41  
12 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly  
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public  
17 utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and  
18

19 **WHEREAS** the Seventh Day Adventist Church (the “Customer”) operates a recreational camp  
20 facility located off the Trans-Canada Highway, west of the Salmonier Line, and has requested  
21 that Newfoundland Power provide this facility with single-phase electrical service; and  
22

23 **WHEREAS** on January 15, 2016 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a  
24 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a single-phase line extension of approximately  
25 2,964 metres (the “Extension”) to provide service to the Customer’s facility; and  
26

27 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of CIAC Policy: Distribution  
28 Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers, approved by Order P.U. 27(2005),  
29 (the “Policy”), is sixty-nine thousand one hundred ninety-seven dollars and five cents  
30 (\$69,197.05), excluding HST; and  
31

32 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the Company shall apply to the Board for  
33 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line extension  
34 or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and  
35

36 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment  
37 in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the  
38 detriment of its other customers.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**  
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
- 3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of sixty-nine thousand one hundred ninety-seven  
4 dollars and five cents (\$69,197.05), excluding HST, to provide single-phase service to  
5 Seventh Day Adventist Church is approved.

7 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


