19	WHEREAS on June 23, 2017 the Oliver Wyman Report was provided to Security National for
20	comments; and

22	WHEREAS on June 27, 2017 Security National advised it had no comment on the Oliver
23	Wyman Report except that it contained a typographical error; and

25	WHEREAS on June 28, 2017 Oliver Wyman filed a report correcting the typographical error;

28	WHEREAS Oliver Wyman finds the proposed rates to be reasonable and supported based on
29	information supplied in connection with the application; and

31	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.
