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4	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
15	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
16	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
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8	WHEREAS on June 1, 2018 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
9	Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase extension of approximately
20	1,493 metres (the "Extension") to serve Domestic Customers located in a cottage area known as
21	Indian Cove located at Ritters Arm, Cottrells Cove/Fortune Harbour Highway; and

23	WHEREAS the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy
24	Distribution Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the
25	"Policy") is fourteen thousand two hundred thirty five dollars and twenty five cents
26	(\$14,235.25), excluding HST; and
27	WITEDEAS Clause 10(i) of the Delice states all line systemsions on amounted involving CIAC
28	WHEREAS Clause 10(i) of the Policy states all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs
29	where the costs calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) are estimated to be greater than \$50,000
30	require approval of the Board; and
31	WHERE AS the sum of the CIAC calculated assument to Clause 5(a) and the Desig Investment
32	WHEREAS the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$60,641.00; and
33 34	calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$60,641.00; and
35	WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment
36	in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the
17	detriment of its other sustamers

## **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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1. The Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of fourteen thousand two hundred thirty five dollars and twenty five cents (\$14,235.25), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers located in a cottage area known as Indian Cove located at Ritters Arm, Cottrells Cove/Fortune Harbour Highway, is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power Inc. shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
