## AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

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20	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
21	existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and
22	is subject to the provisions of the <i>EPCA</i> ; and
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24	WHEREAS subsection 41(3) of the Act states that a public utility shall not proceed with the
25	construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:
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27	a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or
28	b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease
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30	without prior approval of the Board; and
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32	WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 43(2017) the Board approved Hydro's 2018 Capital Budget in
33	the amount of \$170,868,300; and

35	WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 5(2018) the Board approved additional 2018 capital expenditures
36	and an amended 2018 Capital Budget for Hydro in the amount of \$181,193,700; and

**WHEREAS** on January 26, 2018 Hydro filed an application with the Board requesting approval of:

- (i) a capital expenditure in the amount of \$719,400 to perform a voltage conversion of the distribution feeder, Labrador City Feeder VA26; and
- (ii) a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") in the amount of \$50,380, excluding HST (the "Application"); and

WHEREAS the Application stated that on June 26, 2017 Hydro received a request from the Smoky Mountain Ski Club to increase its power supply in the amount of 450kVA to the end of a 3.5 km distribution line on the Labrador City Distribution System effective September 2018; and

**WHEREAS** the Application stated that the current distribution system cannot support the additional load and the least cost feasible alternative is the voltage conversion of the distribution feeder; and

WHERAS the Application also stated that it received a request from the Iron Ore Company of Canada on behalf of the Smokey Mountain Ski Club for the approval of a CIAC in relation to four new line extensions to connect the Smoky Mountain Ski Club; and

**WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC, calculated in accordance with the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the "Policy"), is fifty thousand three hundred and eighty dollars (\$50,380), excluding HST; and

WHEREAS the Application was circulated to Newfoundland Power Inc., the Consumer Advocate, Dennis Browne, Q.C., Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited, NARL Refining Limited Partnership, Vale Newfoundland and Labrador Limited, Teck Resources Limited and Praxair Canada Inc.; and

**WHEREAS** the Board issued requests for information which were answered by Hydro on February 12, 2018; and

**WHEREAS** on February 19, 2018 Hydro filed a submission stating that the capital works and the CIAC are necessary to ensure that it can continue to provide service which is safe and adequate and just and reasonable; and

WHEREAS the Board did not receive any other submissions; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed 2018 supplemental capital expenditure for the voltage conversion of the distribution feeder, Labrador City Feeder VA26, is necessary to ensure the continued provision of a safe and reliable electricity supply to Hydro's customers; and

WHEREAS the proposed CIAC for the line extensions to connect the Smokey Mountain Ski Club is necessary to ensure that Hydro's investment is compensatory over the useful life of the extensions and will not be to the detriment of its other customers.

## **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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1. The proposed capital expenditure in the amount of \$719,400 to perform a voltage conversion of the distribution feeder, Labrador City Feeder VA26, is approved.

2. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of fifty thousand three hundred and eighty dollars (\$50,380), excluding HST, for the construction of four new line extensions to connect the Smoky Mountain Ski Club is approved.

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3. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
