14	thereunder came into effect which included mandatory reforms of the automobile insurance

17	WHEREAS the mandatory reforms included the introduction of Direct Compensation Property
18	Damage ("DCPD") coverage for all vehicles and an increase in the deductible applicable to all
19	pain and suffering awards from \$2,500 to \$5,000; and

21	WHEREAS on June 2, 2020 Royal & Sun Alliance Insurance Company of Canada applied to the
22	Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Reform filing option for its Commercial
23	Automobiles – Interurban category of automobile insurance; and

25	WHEREAS the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Reform Filing Guidelines; and

27	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
28	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
29	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
30	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
