1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22 (the
3 “*Act*”), as amended and regulations
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application
7 by XL Specialty Insurance Company for
8 approval to implement a revised rating
9 program for its Public Vehicles category
10 of automobile insurance.

13 **WHEREAS** on June 1, 2020 XL Specialty Insurance Company applied to the Board for approval
14 of a revised rating program under the IAO filing option for the following types of Public Vehicles:
15 (i) Taxis and Limousines; (ii) Ambulances; (iii) Private Buses; (iv) Public Buses; and (v) School
16 Buses; and

18 **WHEREAS** the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rates
19 accepted for use by the Board; and
20

21 **WHEREAS** XL Specialty Insurance Company proposed to adopt the IAO rates for Public
22 Vehicles accepted for use by the Board in Information Bulletin A.I. 2020-06 issued on May 5,
23 2020; and

25 **WHEREAS** XL Specialty Insurance Company does not have any statistical data to develop its
26 own rates; and
27

28 **WHEREAS** there is no impact on the overall rate level as a result of this proposal since XL
29 Specialty Insurance Company does not currently write any individually rated automobile policies
30 in the province; and

32 **WHEREAS** the revised rating program is consistent with the IAO Filing Guidelines and is
33 supported; and

35 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
36 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the

1 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
2 Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.

5 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


