13	thereunder came into effect which included mandatory reforms of the automobile insurance
14	product; and

16	WHEREAS the mandatory reforms included the introduction of Direct Compensation Property
17	Damage ("DCPD") coverage for all vehicles and an increase in the deductible applicable to all
18	pain and suffering awards from \$2,500 to \$5,000; and

20	WHEREAS on June 30, 2020 Verassure Insurance Company applied to the Board for approval of
21	a revised rating program under the Reform filing option for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category
22	of automobile insurance, including Antique Vehicles, ATVs, Camper Units, Motorcycles,
23	Motorhomes, Snow Vehicles and Trailers; and

25	WHEREAS Verassure Insurance Company has no relevant exposures in the province and
26	proposed to adopt the most recent rates and risk classification system of its partner company,
27	Northbridge General Insurance Corporation; and

29	WHEREAS in Order No. A.I. 46(2020) Northbridge General Insurance Corporation received
30	approval for a revised rating program for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile
