19	accepted for use by the Board; and

21	WHEREAS the IAO filing option may also be used to introduce deviations to the IAO rating
22	program by insurers that are proposing to adopt or are currently using IAO rates; and

24	WHEREAS Liberty Mutual Insurance Company proposed to adopt the IAO rates for Private
25	Passenger Vehicles accepted for use by the Board in Information Bulletin A.I. 2020-06 issued on
26	May 5, 2020; and

28	WHEREAS no deviations to the IAO rating program are proposed; and

30	WHEREAS Liberty Mutual Insurance Company does not have sufficient company loss
31	experience to prepare an independent actuarially based filing; and

WHEREAS the revised rating program is consistent with the IAO Filing Guidelines and is

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
