16	Commercial Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and

18	WHEREAS FICC proposed to align with its partner company, Northbridge General Insurance
19	Company ("NGIC"), by adopting the same rating program, underwriting rule changes and rating
20	rule changes approved for NGIC in Order No. A.I. 43(2021); and

22	WHEREAS FICC noted that it has zero exposures; and

24	WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines and is
25	supported; and

27	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
28	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
29	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the <i>Automobile Insurance Act</i> or the
30	<i>Insurance Companies Act</i> or the respective regulations thereunder.
