AND

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
MACKENZIE AMBULANCE SERVICE INC.
FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE ISSUANCE OF A
MOTOR CARRIER CERTIFICATE.

WHEREAS by application, dated May 14, 2001, completed in accordance with the said Act and Regulations, MacKenzie Ambulance Service Inc. applied to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities for approval of the issuance of a Motor Carrier Certificate to operate the services described in the Schedules attached hereto, and

WHEREAS after public notice, the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities received an objection to the granting of the application from the Department of Health and Community Services (the Department), and

WHEREAS the Department proposed an alternate service territory wording, and

WHEREAS the Applicant on July 30, 2001 agreed to amend the published service territory wording to reflect that proposed by the Department, and

WHEREAS the Department was requested on two occasions to notify the Board regarding the status of their objection, and

WHEREAS the Board, after reviewing all information before it, determined that the Applicant had amended the service territory wording so as to address the matters objected to by the Department, and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the applicant has met the requirements of the Motor Carrier Act and Regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The application of MacKenzie Ambulance Service Inc. be and it is hereby approved and a Motor Carrier Certificate granted.
