The Public Utilities Board has been requested by the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador to review and report on a number of auto insurance issues including the impact of using monetary limits (caps) or deductibles for pain and suffering, the elimination of rating based on age, gender and marital status, and other cost saving measures.
