**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO
2008 CAPITAL BUDGET APPLICATION**

TAKE NOTICE that on July 23, 2007 the Newfoundland and Labrador Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the “Board”) received an application (the “Application”) from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) requesting an Order of the Board pursuant to Sections 41 and 78 of the *Public Utilities Act* (the “Act”):

- i) Approving its 2008 Capital Budget in the amount of \$45,061,000;
- ii) Approving Hydro’s 2008 capital purchases and construction projects in excess of \$50,000;
- iii) Approving Hydro’s proposed estimated Contributions in Aid of Construction of approximately \$275,000; and
- iv) Fixing and determining of a 2006 rate base in the amount of \$1,472,184,000.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any or all customers of Hydro may be affected by the Application.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that anyone interested in participating in this Application must submit a Notice of Intention to Participate to the Board **before 12:00 noon, Friday, August 17, 2007**. The Notice can be in the form of a letter and should clearly state the intended participant’s interests, issues and concerns. Notices of Intention to Participate must include contact information, including address and telephone number. Further communication as to the application process and timing will be made with participants directly.
